PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61539 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Edward T. Harrison, Jr. of 1681 Hammel Road, Eagle Point, Oregon 97524, phone 826-9585, for the use of the waters of Rogue River measured at the point of diversion from the stream or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, and 80.0 acre-feet stored water only from Lost Creek Reservoir constructed under Permit R-8142, tributaries of Pacific Ocean, for the PURPOSE of irrigation and supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 14, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.75 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 650 feet South and 650 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 4, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 4, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow, and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 1-07-10-W0289 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
