PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62158 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Ralph Staver dba Applegate Farm of 110 Stratford Court, Del Mar, California 92014, phone (714)755-7334, for the use of the waters of Applegate Lake Reservoir constructed under Permit R-7810, a tributary of Applegate River, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 7, 1981 for 20.0 acre-feet and October 22, 1982 for 14.0 acre-feet, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 34.0 acre-feet stored water only.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,040 feet North and 910 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 8, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 8, Township 40 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Jackson. Applegate Dam is located in S 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section 25, Township 40 South, Range 4 West, WM.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 2-07-10-W0466 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
