PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63042 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Carl Gutmann of Route 1, Box 122, Cornelius, Oregon 97113, phone 647-5810, for the use of the waters of East Fork Dairy Creek, a tributary of Tualatin River, for the PURPOSE of nursery use; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 12, 1981 for 0.01 cubic foot per second of water and October 25, 1982 for 0.04 cfs, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.05 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 150 feet North and 1,290 feet West from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 16, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 16, Township 2 North, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 2 North Range 3 West, WM Section 16 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 4.0 acres nursery use

The use of water under this permit shall be limited to the period of October 1 to April 30 of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
