## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63227 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to John T. Tibbels and Rosemaric Tibbels of 104 NE Scott Drive, Gresham, Oregon 97030, phone 666-7609, for the use of the waters of South Yamhill River, a tributary of Yamhill River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and stock water; being 6.005 cubic foot per second of water for domestic use for one family and 0.005 cfs for stock water; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 25, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,270 feet North and 1,000 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 32, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 32, Township 5 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Yambill.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 5 South Range 6 West, WM Section 32 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Domestic use for one family and stock use

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
