PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63390 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Harvey Raymond Dickey of 2543 Hamilton Lane, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 476-2533, for the use of the waters of Grave Creek, a tributary of Rogue River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 11, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2,850 feet South and 1,800 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 6, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 6, Township 34 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 34 South Range 6 West, WM Section 6 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for one family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
