PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63693 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Jerry Robert Stevens and Barbara Jane Stevens of 27450 Riggs Hill Road, Sweet Home, Oregon 97386, phone 367-2022, for the use of the waters of two springs, tributaries of Wiley Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and irrigation; being 0.005 cubic foot per second of water from Spring 1 for domestic use and 0.01 cfs from Spring 2 for irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 21, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.015 cfs measured at the points of diversion from the stream, or their equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 (Spring 1) - 1,300 feet South and 910 feet West; Diversion 2 (Spring 2) - 860 feet South and 70 feet West, both from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 35, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 35, Township 13 South, Range I East, WM, in the County of Linn.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 13 South Range I East, WM Section 35 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 0.1 acre and domestic use for one family NE 1/4 NW 1/4 0.5 acre

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
