PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63795 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Stanley L. and Gwen M. Snook of 3286 Snowy Butte Lane, Central Point, Oregon 97502, phone 664-1316, for the use of the waters of North Fork Rogue River, a tributary of Rogue River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and irrigation; being 0.005 cubic foot per second of water for domestic use and 0.01 cfs for irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 28, 1982 for 0.005 cfs and October 25, 1982 for 0.01 cfs, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 590 feet South and 100 feet East from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 29, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 29, Township 33 South, Range 3 East, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 33 South Range 2 East, WM Section 9 NW 1/4 SE 1/4

Domestic use for one family and 0.5 acre irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
