### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64180 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Lance S. Szymanski of PO Box 141, Glide, Oregon 97443, phone 496-3954, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Little River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 27, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,270 feet South and 520 feet West from the Center Quarter Corner of Section 33, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 33, Township 26 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
