### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61912 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Gordon E. Hoffman of Route 3, Box 265-C, Hillsboro, Oregon 97123, phone 647-2975, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir to be constructed under Application R-61911, Permit R-8529, tributaries of McKay Creek, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 18, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.31 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 300 feet North and 200 feet West from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 31, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 31, Township 2 North, Range 2 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 2 North	Range 2 West, WM	Section 31	SE 1/4	NE 1/4	9.5 acres
		Section 32	SW 1/4	NW 1/4	15.4 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-8529, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, provided further water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 30, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
