PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63482 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Harold Olson for United States Deschutes National Forest, Sisters Ranger District, 25550 Lawrence Road, Junction City, Oregon 97448, phone 935-3512, for the use of the waters of Metolius River, a tributary of Deschutes River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including irrigation of lawn and noncommercial garden not exceeding 0.25 acre in area; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 21, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,190 feet South and 630 feet East from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 10, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 10, Township 13 South, Range 9 East, WM, in the County of Jefferson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 30, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
