PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64159 and do hereby great the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Robert Epler of Route 1, Box 185, Forest Grove, Oregon 97116, phone 357-5141 (work) or 357-2343 (home), for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir to be constructed under Application R-64158, Permit R-8536, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITIES OF THE RIGHT date from September 15, 1982 for 0.70 cfs and November 9, 1982 for 0.13 cfs, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.83 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: <u>Unnamed stream - 1,400</u> feet North and 500 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 18, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 18 and Reservoir - 1,200 feet North and 930 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 18, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 and SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 18, all within Township 2 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-8536, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 30, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
