PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62748 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Bonnie J. Baker of PO Box 652, Merlin, Oregon 97532, for the use of the waters of Unnamed Stream 1 with any deficiency in the available supply from Stream 1 to be made up by appropriation from Streams 2 and 3, tributaries of Dog Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for three families and irrigation, being 0.01 cubic foot per second of water for domestic use and 0.09 cfs for irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 14, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.1 cfs measured at the points of diversion from the stream, or their equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 (Unnamed Stream 1) - 1,319 feet South and 270 feet West; Diversion 2 (Unnamed Stream 2) - 1,319 feet South and 322 feet West; Diversion 3 (Unnamed Stream 3) - 600 feet South; all from the Northeast Corner of Section 20, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 20, Township 34 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 34 South Range 6 West, WM Section 20 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for three families and 20.0 acres irrigation from Stream 1 with any deficiency to be made up from Streams 2 and 3

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 7, 1984 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
