PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63817 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Frank A. Currie of 13400 SW Village Glen Court, Tigard, Oregon 97223, phone 639-7799, for the use of the waters of an unnamed creek, a tributary of North Fork Nehalem River, for the PURPOSE of operation of a hydraulic ram and domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden; being 9/800 cubic foot per second of water for operation of the hydraulic ram and 1/800 cfs for domestic use; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 2, 1982 for domestic use and October 7, 1982 for operation of the hydraulic ram, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1/80 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 150 feet North and 60 feet West from the W 1/16 Corner of the common section line between Section 32, Township 4 North, Range 9 West and Section 5, Township 3 North, Range 9 West, WM, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 32, Township 4 North, Range 9 West, WM, in the County of Clatsop.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 7, 1984 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
