PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 60347 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Clay Kenna Jordan of 460 Jordan Lane, Roseburg, Oregon 97470, phone 673-1931, for the use of the waters of Doerner Creek and Jordan Reservoir to be constructed under Application R-60346, Permit R-8544, tributaries of Champagne Creek, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 11, 1980, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 895 feet North and 310 feet West from the S1/4 Corner of Section 4, being within the SE1/4 SW1/4 of Section 4, Township 27 South, Range 7 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 27 South Range 7 West, WM Section 4 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 20.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage of water from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-8544, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on your before January 14, 1984 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
