## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62428 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Cheryl Yasui Sparks of 2628 Meadowbrook Road, Hood River, Oregon 97031, phone 386-4265, for the use of the waters of two streams; being <u>0.04</u> cubic foot per second of water from the south stream when available with any deficiency in the available supply from the south stream to be made up by appropriation from the north stream, provided that the total quantity diverted from both sources does not exceed <u>0.04</u> cfs, tributaries of Neal Creek, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRICRITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 31, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed <u>0.04</u> cfs measured at the points of diversion from the streams, or their equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The PCINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: <u>Diversion 1 (South Stream)</u> - 1,224 feet South and 50 feet East; <u>Diversion 2 (North Stream)</u> - 756 feet South and 108 feet East, both from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 24, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 24, Township 2 North, Range 10 East, WM, in the County of Hood River.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 2 North Range 10 East, WM Section 24 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 0.8 acre NE 1/4 NW 1/4 2.2 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 14, 1984 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
