PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63784 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Seppo Aaltonen of Route 3, Box 3098, Clatskanie, Oregon 97016, phone 728-4120, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and an unnamed spring, tributaries of Beaver Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 23, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 8.01 cubic foot per second measured at the points of diversion from the stream, or their equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: <u>Diversion 1 (Stream)</u> - 605 feet South and 583 feet East; <u>Diversion 2 (Spring)</u> - 374 feet South and 594 feet East, both from the Center of Section 3, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 3, Township 7 North, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Columbia.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 7 North Range 4 West, WM Section 3 NE 1/4 SW 1/4

Domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 14, 1984 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
