## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63955 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Eric Douglas Wicklund of 3951 Maple Isle Farm Road, Springfield, Oregon 97477, phone 726-7577, for the use of the waters of McKenzie River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RICHT dates from August 25, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.64 cubic foot per second measured at the points of diversion from the stream, or their equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 1,200 feet South and 2,150 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 15, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 15; Diversion 2 - 1,950 feet South and 1,450 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 15, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 15, both within Township 17 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Lane.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per scre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 14, 1984 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
