## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64507 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Otto V. Epping of 2244 State Street, North Bend, Oregon 97459, phone 756-6517, for the use of the waters of two unnamed streams; being 0.07 cubic foot per second of water from Stream 1 and 0.01 cfs from Stream 2, tributaries of Coquille River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 27, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.08 cfs measured at the points of diversion from the streams, or their equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 (Stream 1) - 75 feet North and 650 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 20, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 17; Diversion 2 (Stream 2) - 720 feet South and 1,285 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 20, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 20, both being within Township 27 South, Range 13 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 27 South Range 13 West, WM Section 20 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 5

5.3 acres from Unnamed Stream I and 0.5 acre from Unnamed Stream 2

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per scre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each scre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 14, 1984 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984. Extended to Oct. 1, 1986

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985. Extended to Oct. 1, 1986.
