PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64557 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to A-BAR-L Ranch by King Williams of PO Box 310, Canyon City, Oregon 97820, phone 575-0597, for the use of the waters of Canyon Creek and Alder Guich; being 0.16 cubic foot per second of water from Canyon Creek and 0.09 cfs from Alder Guich when available with any deficiency in the available supply from Alder Guich to be made up by appropriation from Canyon Creek provided that the total quantity diverted from both sources shall not exceed 0.09 cfs, tributaries of John Day River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 26, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.25 cfs measured at the points of diversion from the stream, or their equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 (Alder Gulch) - 2,170 feet South and 2,100 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 19, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 19; Diversion 2 (Canyon Creek) - 2,300 feet South and 2,080 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 19, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 19; Diversion 3 (Canyon Creek) - 1,400 feet South and 1,120 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 19, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 19; Diversion 4 (Canyon Creek) - 300 feet South and 780 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 24, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 24, all within Township 15 South, Range 31 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 14, 1984 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
