PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Oregon Aqua-Foods, Inc. of 88700 Marcola Road, Springfield, Oregon 97477, phone 746-4484, for the use of the waters of cooling wastewater from the Springfield Weyerhaeuser pulp and paper plant, for the PURPOSE of fish culture,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 8, 1982,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED. 5.0 feet North and 1,900 feet East from the Southwest Corner of SW I/4 of Section 29, being within the SE I/4 SW I/4 of Section 29, Township 17 South, Range 2 West, WM, in the County of Lane.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 14, 1984 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 85
