PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61185 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to A.L. Duckett of PO Box 518, Imnaha, Oregon 97842, phone 577-3141, for the use of the waters of Camp Creek, a tributary of Imnaha River,

for the PURPOSE of stock water,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 8, 1982,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,380 feet South and 1,290 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 19, being within SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 19, Township 1 North, Range 48 East, WM, in the County of Wallows.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township I North, Range 48 East, WM Section 20 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Stock water SW 1/4 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 SE 1/4

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 14, 1984 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 85.
