PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64620 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Mary B. Hensley of PC Box 902, Bandon, Oregon 97411, phone 347-3656, and Jackman and Alice Hutchins of Bates Road, Bandon, Oregon 97411, phone 347-2043, for the use of the waters of a spring area,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for two families including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden each, being 0.01 cubic foot per second each,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 7, 1983,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 (Hensley) - 364 feet West and 139 feet South; Diversion 2 (Hutchins) - 154 feet South and 362 feet West, both from the NW 1/16 Corner of Section 29, being within SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 29, Township 28 South, Range 14 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 28 South, Range 14 West, WM Section 29 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for two families including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden each

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 14, 1984 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
