PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

61245 This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61245 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Dana P. Stone of Medical Springs Stage, Baker, Oregon 97814, phone 853-2361, for the use of the waters of Price's Gulch, Langrell Gulch and a spring,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family, stock, and supplemental irrigation, being 0.005 cubic foot per second of water from a spring for domestic use, 0.01 cfs from Price's Guich for stock use, and 0.01 cfs from Langrell Guich for irrigation. that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 12, 1981,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed second.

Diversion 1 (spring) - 2,085 feet South and 1,155 feet East: The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED. Diversion 1 (spring) - 2,085 feet South and 1,155 feet Last; Diversion 2 (Langrell Guich) - 2,065 feet South and 1,055 feet East; Diversion 3 (Price's Guich) - 2,415 feet South and 890 feet East, all from the Northwest Corner of Section 5, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 5, Township 7 South, Range 42 East, WM, in the County of Baker.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 7 South, Range 42 East, WM

Section 5 SW 1/4

NW 1/4 Domestic use for one family, stock use, and supplemental irrigation of 0.02 acre

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation sesson of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state-officer.

February 23, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with Actual construction work shall begin on or before reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 84 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 85 .
