PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **62979** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Erven Witty of Route 1, Box 171, Enterprise, Oregon 97828, phone 426-3567,** for the use of the waters of an unnamed spring branch and Spring Creek; being 0.44 cubic foot per second of water from the unnamed spring branch and 0.30 cfs from Spring Creek, for the PURPOSE of **irrigation,**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **November 8, 1982,**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.74 cubic foot per second.**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **Diversion 1 (Spring Creek) - 750 feet North and 1,275 feet East from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 11, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 11; Diversion 2 (Spring Creek) - 830 feet South and 360 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 11, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 11; Diversion 3 (Unnamed Spring Branch) - 620 feet South and 630 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 10, being within the***

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
Township 2 South, Range 44 East, WM Section 10 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 17.50 acres from the unnamed spring branch
2.50 acres from Spring Creek
Section 11 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 2.50 acres from Spring Creek
7.05 acres from Spring Creek

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

*NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 10, all being within Township 2 South, Range 44 East, WM, in the County of Wallowa.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **February 23, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 1984**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before **October 1, 1985**.
