## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63832 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following

This permit is issued to Devils Lake Golf Club, Inc. of PO Box 30, Lincoln, Oregon 97367, phone 994-8442, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and two reservoirs to be enlarged and constructed under Application R-63831, Permit R-8553, for the PURPOSE of irrigation,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 10, 1982,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.09 cubic feet per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 20 feet North and 1,420 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 35, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 35, Township 6 South, Range II West, WM; Diversion 2 - 510 feet South and 1,500 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 35, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 2, Township 7 South, Range 11 West, WM, both in the County of Lincoln.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 6 South, Range 11 West, WM

Section 35 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 39.2 acres

Section 36

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 18.7 acres

Township 7 South, Range 11 West, WM

Section 2 NW 1/4 NE 1/4

12.8 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4 16.4 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage of water from two reservoirs to be constructed under Permit R-8553, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 23, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with Extended to Oct. 1, 1986 Extended to October 1987 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 84 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 85 . Extended to Oct. 1, 1986 Extended to Oct. 2
