PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64411 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Norbert L. Sieg and Desmond D. Sieg of 139 South Foothill Drive, Baker, Oregon 97814, phone 523-4022, for the use of the waters of surface drainage water collected by draintiles and Sieg's Ponds 1, 2, 3, and 4 to be constructed under Application R-64410, Permit* for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 4, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 17.4 cubic feet per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 1,811 feet North and 1,370 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 21, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 21; Diversion 1 ond 1) - 1,652 feet North and 2,675 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 21, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 21; Diversion 3 (Pond 2) - 1,652 feet North and 2,325 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 21, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 21;**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: Township 8 South, Range 39 East, WM Section 15 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 38-8 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic feet per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage of water from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-8554, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
