PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64499 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to North Unit Irrigation District of 2024 SW Beech Street, Madras, Oregon 97741, phone 475-3625, for the use of the waters of Crooked River, a tributary of Deschutes River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 21, 1982,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 3.09 cubic feet per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 590 feet North and 2,790 feet East from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 13, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 13, Township 14 South, Range 13 East, WM, in the County of Deschutes.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
