PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

64521 This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Sandy Fisher of 705 NE 7th Street, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 476-6000, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Applegate River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 1, 1982,

0.07 cubic foot per and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed

215 feet South and 170 feet West from the Northeast Corner The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED. 213 feet South and 170 feet freet from the roots of SW 1/4 NE. 1/4 of Section 29, being within the SW 1/4 NE. 1/4 of Section 29, Township 37 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 37 South, Range 5 West, WM

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 29

2.6 acres

SW 1/4 NE 1/4

3.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre. from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 23, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 84 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 85.
