PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64552 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Ronald D. Quigley of Route I, Western Heights, Baker, Oregon 97814, phone 523-6825, for the use of the waters of an unnamed spring, a tributary of Quigley Creek.

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for 19 families including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden each,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 24, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,215 feet South and 2,315 feet East from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 13, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 13, Township 9 South, Range 39 East, WM, in the County of Baker.
