PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61873 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Rex E. Miller of 700 West Catching Inlet, Coos Bay, Oregon 97420, phone 269-1971, for the use of the waters of three unnamed drainageways and two reservoirs to be constructed under Application R-63262, Permit R-8596; being 0.043 cubic foot per second of* for the PURPOSE of irrigation,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 11, 1983,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.129 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 1,245 feet North and 1,200 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 6, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 6; Diversion 2 - 1,229 feet North and 1,315 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 6, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 6; Diversion 3 - 1,153 feet North and 1,690 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 6, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 6, all being within Township 26**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 26 South, Range 12 West, WM Section 6 NW 1/4 SE 1/4 10.0 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4 0.5 acre

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoirs to be constructed under Permit R-8596, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
