62127 This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62127 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

supplemental irrigation, for the PURPOSE of

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 2, 1982.

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 47.4 acre-feet stored water only.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 1,904.26 feet North and 1,172.28 feet West; Diversion 2 - 1,572 feet North and 1,246 feet West, both from the Southeast Corner of Section 6, being within the NE I/4 SE I/4 of Section 6, Township 37 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Josephine; Applegate Dam is located in S I/2 SE I/4 of Section 25, Township 40 South, Range 4 West, WM, In the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 2-07-10-W0452 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director.
