PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **62127** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Suzanne K. Poett of 501 Roehampton Road, Hillsborough, California 94010, phone (415)343-0800, for the use of the waters of Applegate Lake Reservoir constructed under Permit R-7810,**

for the PURPOSE of **supplemental irrigation,**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **December 2, 1982,**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **47.4 acre-feet stored water only.**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **Diversion 1 - 1,904.26 feet North and 1,172.28 feet West; Diversion 2 - 1,572 feet North and 1,246 feet West, both from the Southeast Corner of Section 6, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 6, Township 37 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Josephine; Applegate Dam is located in S 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section 25, Township 40 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 2-07-10-W0452 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director.

*South, Range 12 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **March 14, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **84**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **85**.
