PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63796 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Ralph W. Giffin of 29B Guines Creek, Azalea, Oregon 97410, phone 837-3422, for the use of the waters of Guines Creek and a spring,

for the PURPOSE of Irrigation and domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden, being 0.035 cubic foot per second of water from Guines Creek for irrigation and 0.01 cfs from the spring for domestic use, that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 28, 1982,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.045 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 (Spring) - 200 feet South and 1,450 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 35, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 35; Diversion 2 (Guines Creek) - 270 feet South and 820 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 35, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 35, both within Township 32 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 32 South, Range 5 West, WM Section 35 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden NW 1/4 NW 1/4 2.5 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/70 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 14, 1984 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985
