A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 9 South, Range 27 East, WM

Section 5

Supplemental irrigation NE 1/4 SW 1/4 2.6 acres

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 1.5 acres

Primary irrigation SE 1/4 SW 1/4 18.0 acres

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 8 2.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
