PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63053 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Gerry Lehrburger of 10417 Highway 238, Jacksonville, Oregon 97530, phone 899-7445, for the use of the waters of Little Applegate River, a tributary of Applegate River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation and domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden; being 0.045 cubic foot per second of water for irrigation and 0.005 cfs for domestic use,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 10, 1983,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 225 feet North and 860 feet West from the S1/4 Corner of Section 24, being within the SE1/4 SW1/4 of Section 24, Township 39 South, Range 2 West, WMi, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 39 South, Range 2 West, WM S

Section 24 SE 1/4 SW 1/4

1.75 acres and domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 22, 1984 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 84.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 85 .
