PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64168 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Warmsprings Irrigation District of 334 North Main Street, Vale, Oregon 97918, phone 386-1233, for the use of the waters of Malheur River, a tributary of Snake River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 23, 1982,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.51 cubic feet per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 480 feet South and 10 feet West from the Northeast Corner of NW I/4 NE I/4 of Section 4, being within the NW I/4 NE I/4 of Section 4, Township 19 South, Range 43 East, WM, in the County of Malheur.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 19 South, Range 44 East, WM Section 17 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 9.1 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4 16.2 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4 32.3 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 2.8 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 22, 1984 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 84.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 85 .
