PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **64558** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Hans P. Zenthoefer** of **14575 South Jordan Road, Mulino, Oregon 97042**, phone **829-9615**, for the use of the waters of **Milk Creek, springs, winter runoff and a reservoir constructed under Permit R-8199; being 0.19 cubic foot per second of water from Milk Creek*** for the PURPOSE of **irrigation and supplemental irrigation,**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **November 29, 1982,**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.19 cubic foot per second.**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **Diversion 1 (Milk Creek) - 10 feet North and 200 feet East from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 28, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 21; Diversion 2 (Pond) - 660 feet South and 570 feet East from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 28, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 28, all within Township 4 South, Range 2 East, WM, in the County of Clackamas.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 4 South, Range 2 East, WM	Section 28	NW 1/4	NE 1/4	3.0 acres
		SW 1/4	NE 1/4	12.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage of water from reservoir constructed under Permit R-8199, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

*for irrigation, 0.19 cfs from the springs, winter runoff and reservoir for supplemental irrigation,

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **March 22, 1984** and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 1984**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before **October 1, 1985**.
