PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

64578 This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64578 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Frank Asher of PO Box 365, Mt. Vernon, Oregon 97865, phone 932-4628, for the use of the waters of John Day River, a tributary of Columbia River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 14, 1982,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.32 cubic foot per

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 250 feet North and 1,010 feet East from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 6, being within Lot 5 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4) of Section 6; Diversion 2 - 150 feet North and 930 feet East from the WI/4 Corner of Section 6, being within Lot 5 (SWI/4 NW 1/4) of Section 6; Diversion 3 - 3,340 feet South and 670 feet East from the S 1/4 Corner of Section 6, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 7, all within Township 11 South,

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
