PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64594 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Lester A. and Florence N. Powers of 4113 Via Picaposte, Palos Verdes, California 90274, phone (213)378-1369, for the use of the waters of Trail Creek, a tributary of Rogue River,

for the PURPOSE of stock water,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 27, 1982,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2,200 feet North and 1,630 feet East from the Quarter Corner of Sections 17 and 20, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 17, Township 33 South, Range I West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 33 South, Range I West, WM Section 17 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Stock water

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 22, 1984 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19
