PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 60588 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to John J. and Gwen K. Atkins of 555 Slagel Creek Road, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 846-6137, for the use of the waters of Applegate River, a tributary of Rogue River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation and supplemental irrigation,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 5, 1980,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.04 cubic feet per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 750 feet North and 600 feet West from the S 1/4 Corner of Section 6, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 6, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to <sup>1/80<sup>th</sup></sup> ~~1/40~~ of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further, that although declared herein to be supplemental irrigation in part, the right allowed may, in the interest of conserving the ground water supplies, be exercised at times when water is available in the ground water supply provided that the total quantity diverted from all sources of supply does not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 15, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986.
