PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63453 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to John Atkins of 555 Slagle Creek Road, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 846-6147, for the use of the waters of Applegate Reservoir constructed under Permit R-7810, a tributary of Applegate River, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 6, 1982,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 60 acre-feet stored water only.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 750 feet North and 600 feet West from the South 1/4 Corner of Section 6, being within SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 6, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, WM; Applegate Dam is located in the S 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section 25, Township 40 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 2-07-10-W0460 between the Water Resources Service and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 15, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986.
