PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63498 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Bonnie C. Smith of 87448 Territorial Road, Veneta, Oregon 97487, phone 933-4586, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Siuslaw River; and Siuslaw River, a tributary of Pacific Ocean, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and irrigation, being 0.005 cubic foot per second from the unnamed stream for domestic use, 0.12 cfs from the unnamed stream for irrigation and 0.13 cfs from Siuslaw River for irrigation, that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 3, 1983,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.255 cfs.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 1,930 feet North and 670 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 18, being within NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 18; Diversion 2 - 360 feet North and 1,120 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 18, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 18, both being within Township 18 South, Range 8 West, WM, in the County of Lane.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 15, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986.
