PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

63498 This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

Bonnie C. Smith of 87448 Territorial Road, Veneta, Oregon 97487, phone This permit is issued to 935-4586, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Siuslaw River; and Siuslaw River, a tributary of Pacific Ocean,

domestic use for one family and irrigation, being 0.005 cubic foot per second for the PURPOSE of trom the unnamed stream for domestic use, 0.12 cfs from the unnamed stream for irrigation and 0.13 cfs from Siuslaw River for irrigation,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 3, 1983,

0.255 cfs. and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed

Diversion 1 - 1,930 feet North and 670 feet West from the The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 = 1,350 feet North and 670 feet west from the Southeast Corner of Section 18, being within NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 18; Diversion 2 - 360 feet North and 1,120 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 18, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 18, both being within Township 18 South, Range 8 West, WM, in the County of Lane.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
