## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **64793** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Anthony Alan Fletcher (President of Teal Creek Farms, Inc.)** of 18995 Frost Road, Dallas, Oregon 97338, phone 787-3027, for the use of the waters of Teal Creek, a tributary of Little Luckiamute River, for the PURPOSE of **irrigation,**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **January 26, 1983,**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.19 cubic foot per second.**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **Diversion 1 - 538 feet North and 113 feet East from the West 1/4 Corner of Section 27; Diversion 2 - 269 feet North and 631 feet East from the West 1/4 Corner, Section 27; Diversion 3 - 213 feet North and 994 feet East from the West 1/4 Corner of Section 27, all being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 27, Township 8 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Polk.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 8 South, Range 6 West, WM	Section 27 SW 1/4 NW 1/4	6.87 acres
	NW 1/4 SW 1/4	8.40 acres
	NE 1/4 SW 1/4	0.23 acre

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **April 15, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19**85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19**86**.
