PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64802 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Beulah B. (Carter) Burton of 306 Hardcash Lane, Camas Valley, Oregon 97416, phone 445-2290, for the use of the waters of Mill Creek, a tributary of Middle Fork Coquille,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation and domestic use for one family, being 0.05 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.005 cfs for domestic use,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 31, 1983,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.055 cfs.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 30 feet South and 160 feet East, from the Southwest Corner of the NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 31, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 31, Township 29 South, Range 8 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 29 South, Range 8 West, WM Section 31 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 2.5 acres and domestic
Township 29 South, Range 9 West, WM Section 36 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 1.5 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The waters of the Middle Fork of the Coquille River and tributaries upstream from the confluence with Holmes Creek are classified only for domestic, livestock and irrigation of lawns and gardens not exceeding one-half acre in area, and instream use for recreation, fish life, and wildlife during the period from July 1 to September 30, of every year.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 15, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986.
