PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64854 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to James Jackson of Route 2, Box 306, Bandon, Oregon 97411, for the use of the waters of two unnamed streams, being 0.045 cubic foot per second from Stream 1 and 0.061 cfs from Stream 2, tributaries of Bear Creek,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation and flood harvesting of cranberries, being 0.023 cfs from Stream 1 for irrigation and 0.045 cfs from Stream 1 for flood harvesting, 0.031 cfs from Stream 2 for irrigation and 0.061 cfs from Stream 2 for flood harvesting,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 22, 1983,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.106 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 60 feet South and 2,100 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 28, being within NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 28; Diversion 2 - 2,340 feet South and 330 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 28, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 28, Township 28 South, Range 14 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 28 South, Range 14 West, WM	Section 28	SE 1/4	NE 1/4	<u>Unnamed Stream 1</u> 0.9 acre cranberry irrigation and flood harvest
		SE 1/4	NE 1/4	<u>Unnamed Stream 2</u> 1.22 acres cranberry irrigation and flood harvest

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second of its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, for cranberries. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 15, 1984 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986.
