PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **61977** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **United States, Crooked River National Grassland, 2321 East Third Street, Prineville, Oregon 97754, phone 447-4120,** for the use of the waters of Mud Springs Creek, a tributary of Lower Deschutes River, for the PURPOSE of **watering of stock and wildlife**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **July 30, 1981**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.005 cfs.**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **2,480 feet North and 2,200 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 16, being within the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 16, Township 11 South, Range 14 East, WM, in the County of Jefferson.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **April 19, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19**85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19**86**.
