PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

61978 This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61978 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to United States, Crooked River National Grassland, 2321 East Third Street, Prineville, Oregon 97754, phone 447-4120, for the use of the waters of Squaw Creek, a tributary of Deschutes River,

for the PURPOSE of water for stock and wildlife

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 30, 1981

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cfs.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 500 feet South and 1,860 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 24, being within the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 24, Township 13 South, Range 11 East, WM, in the County of Jefferson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 13 South, Range 11 East, WM SW 1/4 Wildlife and stock water Section 13 SE 1/4

April 19, 1984 Actual construction work shall begin on or before reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19
