## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61979 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to United States, Crooked River National Grassland, 2321 East Third Street, Prineville, Oregon 97754, phone 447-4120, for the use of the waters of Willow Creek, a tributary of Lower Deschutes River, for the PURPOSE of stock and wildlife watering

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 30, 1981

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cfs.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 260 feet North and 100 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 22, being within the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 22, Township 12 South, Range 14 East, WM, in the County of Jefferson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
