62068 This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62068 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

USDA Forest Service - Malheur National Forest, 139 Northeast Dayton This permit is issued to USDA Porest Service - Maineur National Porest, 139 Northeast Dayton Street, John Day, Oregon 97845, phone 575-1731, for the use of the waters of SW-80 Spring, a tributary of Kate Creek,

for the PURPOSE of livestock watering

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 3, 1981

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed

1,600 feet North and 800 feet West from the Southeast The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED. 1,600 leet North and 800 leet west from the Southeast Corner of Section 21, being within the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 21, Township 16 South, Range 36 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
